

Good supervision of aseptic processing is essential for ensuring a high quality, efficient and safe service. The supervisor plays a crucial role in ensuring that the team understand what is required, follow procedures, adapt to changes in demand and can promptly resolve problems. To do this, the supervisor must communicate effectively with the team and be a positive role model.

An effective supervisor needs a sound knowledge of the processes they are supervising, attention to detail, awareness, problem solving skills and the knowledge of when to escalate issues. This course will raise your awareness of these considerations and more, and provide you with the starting materials to develop yourself into an effective supervisor.

Payment

Payment by debit/credit card should be made at the time of booking via the Online Store.
